## Dates

**September 19 - 24, 2011**

*The workshop will begin at 0900 hours on September 19, 2011 and close at 1600 hours on September 24, 2011. The lodging and boarding arrangements at the venue will be available from September 18 (evening) to September 24 (evening). The participants are expected to reach the venue on September 18, 2011 (evening) and plan their travel accordingly.*

## Venue

Leslie Sawhny Centre, Deolali, District Nashik, Maharashtra

*Deolali, 556.52 meters above sea level, is surrounded by the picturesque Sahyadri ranges. The Leslie Sawhny Centre is situated within the Deolali Cantonment and is at a distance of 8km from Nashik Road railway station, 30 km from Nashik City, and approx 200 km from both Mumbai and Pune.*

## Objective

By the end of the workshop, the participants will have explored, experimented and practiced facilitating participatory theatre processes

## Methodology

The effort will be towards creating a participant-centred environment for experiential learning. The facilitation will explore a wide range of participatory tools and methods to encourage learning from each other.

## Language

Hindi and English will be the working language of the workshop.

### Participants

The workshop is open to participants from CBOs, NGOs, Government departments, theatre groups and educational institutions. The workshop will most benefit participants working on community empowerment issues, with an interest and/or experience in exploring possibilities of theatre in engaging, enabling and empowering communities.

### Participation Fees

Rs.10,000/-

*The participation fee covers stay, food and workshop resources. Accommodation at the venue will be on sharing basis and participants will have a choice of veg and non-veg food. Participants will have to make their own travel arrangements.*
